

# Project proposal Olivia Hendrickx Research Fund Clinical PhD 2019

The Olivia Hendrickx Research Fund will provide PhD fellowships for <u>clinicians associated with a pediatric oncological service</u>. The projects should aim at the improvement of treatment and care of pediatric cancers. The translation of scientific knowledge to clinical practice is the primary aim. The Olivia Hendrickx Research Fund will support both part-time clinical PhD projects and full time clinical PhD projects. The practical research can also be performed in an university laboratory.
